The event combines elements of strategy, deduction, and collaboration for a memorable gaming experience.

EVENT GUIDELINES:

- All the team members registered should be present at the venue by the start time.
- The participants should be present at the venue after the missions completion successfully.
- There should be no changes in the registered members in a team

TEAM SIZE: 3-5Members

PLAN OF ACTION:

Welcome and Orientation (10 minutes):

- Welcome participants, mentors, and judges.
- Provide a brief overview of the event, rules, and logistics.
- Introduce mentors and judges.
- Each crewmember should participate in a mission.
- Event consist of 5 round each with a time limit of 25 minutes.
- Analysis of missions completed by each team.

The results are showed based on the missions completed by each team at each round. There will be discussion on imposter activities found by crewmates. As per these results co-ordinators and mentors are going to show the results.
