Each team will have a designated time slot to present their solution using the prepared PowerPoint.

Presentations should be concise and cover all key aspects of the proposed solution.

A Q&A session with judges will follow each presentation. Teams should be prepared to answer questions and defend their solutions.

Behavior and Conduct:

All participants must maintain professionalism and respect throughout the event.

Any form of misconduct, including disruptive behavior or disrespect towards judges or other participants, will result in immediate disqualification.

Time Management:

Teams are strictly need to the specified time slots for each phase of the event. Late submissions or exceeding allocated presentation times will lead to penalties.
